<i>Coverage/ Organization</i>	1A: Covers the Right Content	5	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The three criteria mirror the three stated content standards.
	1B: Criteria Are Well Organized	??	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> It makes sense to have three separate criteria. Since there are no details, it is difficult to tell how well they are organized. Since no rating scale is proposed, it is difficult to tell about relevant emphasis.
	1C: Number of Levels Fits Targets and Uses	1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The number of levels is not specified.
<i>Clarity</i>	2A: Levels Defined Well	1	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> There is no attempt at defining levels and it is unlikely that independent raters could consistently rate work the same.
	2B: Levels Parallel	??	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No levels are defined, so it is impossible to tell if they are parallel.
