Blake is a 23-year old male. He completed college and was working as assistant store manager when he sustained a moderate TBI as a result of a motor vehicle accident in 2009. Glasgow Coma Scale was 7 when admitted to hospital. Hemorrhagic contusions with depressed skull fracture in right frontal area. Blood noted in anterior temporal tip. Relatively healthy. No medications prescribed at time of testing, 12 months post-injury.
