Combining Tests for a Better Solution



Cognitive ability is measured by four specific types of reasoning: mechanical, spatial, verbal, and numerical—also referred to as general mental ability or g. Although these abilities are unique, there is some overlap between the reasoning types. Correlations between the Watson-Glaser™ Critical Thinking Appraisal, a verbal reasoning assessment, and the new NDIT™ Numerical Data Interpretation Test range from .47 to .50.

What does this mean?

Although scores on the Watson-Glaser have a positive relationship with NDIT scores, NDIT provides additional information. Its scores provide a clearer picture of a candidate's ability to correctly draw logical conclusions and inferences from numerical data above and beyond the critical thinking measured by Watson-Glaser.

Which test is right for my job candidate?

Conduct a job analysis or refer to the job description to determine what type of reasoning is important or frequently used in your open position. Use the Occupation Quick Search in the O*NET database to learn what abilities are important for success in nearly 1,000 different jobs, then simply align the in-demand ability with the corresponding TalentLens Solution.

Combine TalentLens ability assessments with a personality or values inventory for even more insight on candidate potential. Adding a second assessment to your hiring process may increase the combined validity of the test battery, especially when the two tests measure different skills. This evidence, known as incremental validity, is most practical when the candidate testing experience is less than one hour long.


